The SFN Annual Writing Competition, a competition that gives audiences and readers a chance to tell their personal stories, was another initiative we implemented in Q4 of 2024. We got an overwhelming amount of entries for the competition and with the help of an esteemed selection of judges, we got three winners. The winners were compensated with cash prizes and also the noteworthy entries also got cash tokens.

We ended the year with a strong resolve to do more in the coming year 2025 - tell more real stories from real Nigerians, impact more individuals and communities, be more engaging with members of the SFN community and contribute to building a Nigeria we all will be proud of.

Support & Donations:

Our work of creating a change through storytelling is made possible through generous support and donations from inspired individuals, organizations, and partners. In 2024, we received N1,500,800.00 (~ \$998.54 at 2/1/2025 through a committed monthly support of: N125,150.00 (~\$83.27 at 2/1/2025) and onetime donations of N450,000 (~\$299.40 at 2/1/2025).

Accounts & Expenses:

Our current monthly expenses, which include salaries and programming expenses such as Podcasts production, and recording equipment rental is N700,000 (~ \$465.74 at 2/1/2025).

Account Balance:

Our account balance as of the time of writing this update is N21,829.15 (~\$14.52 at 2/1/2025).
